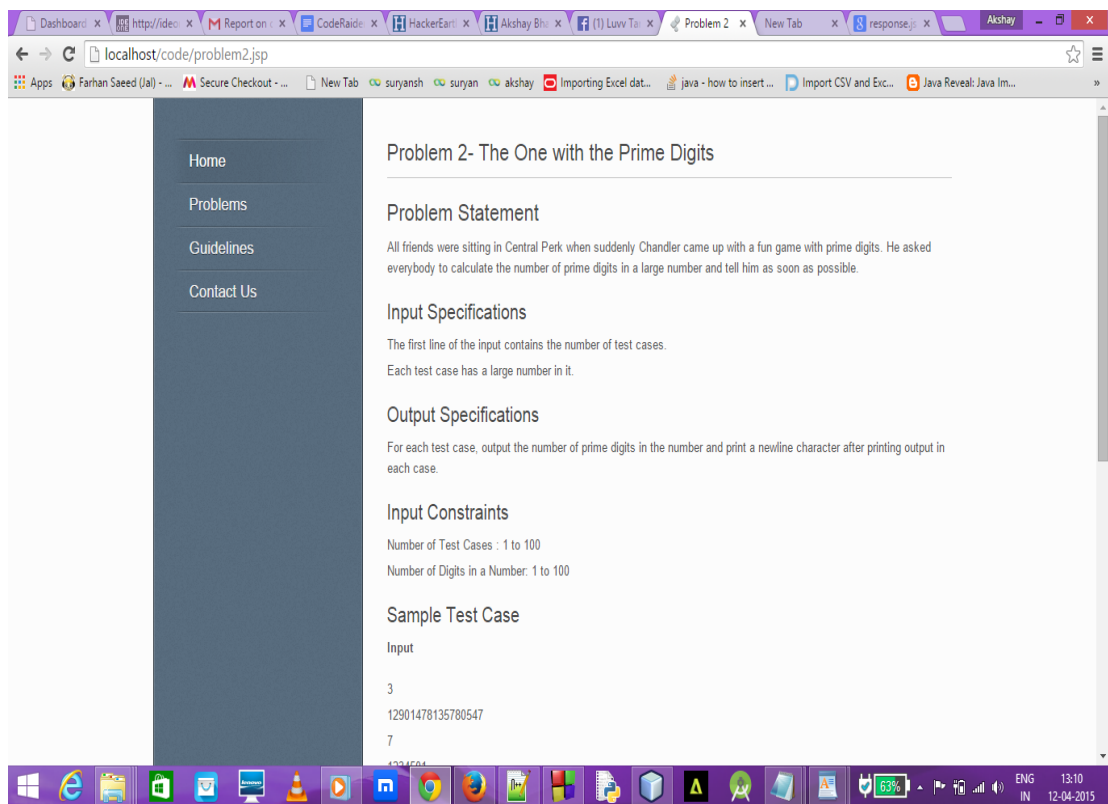


Technical Events organized by Student Clubs

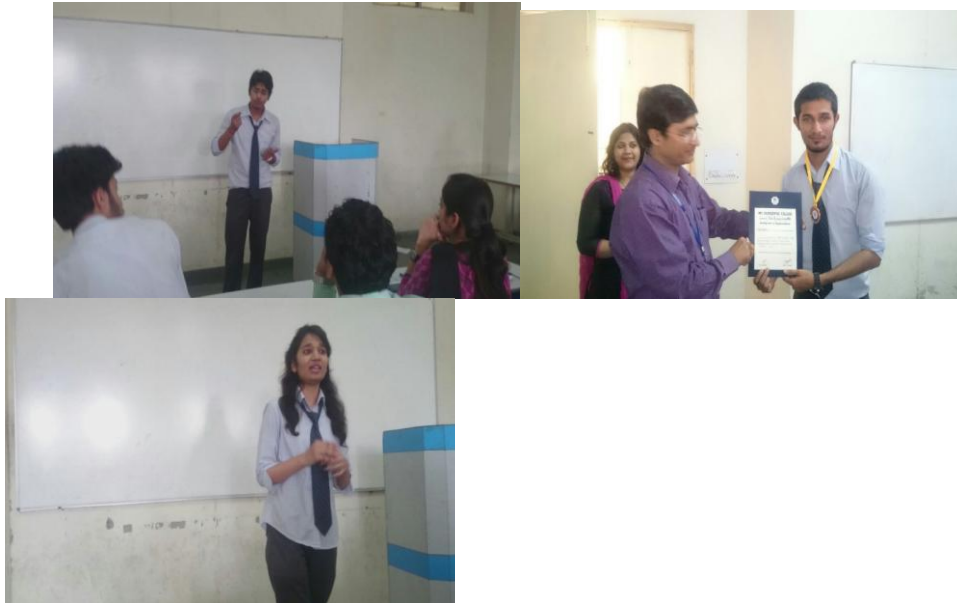

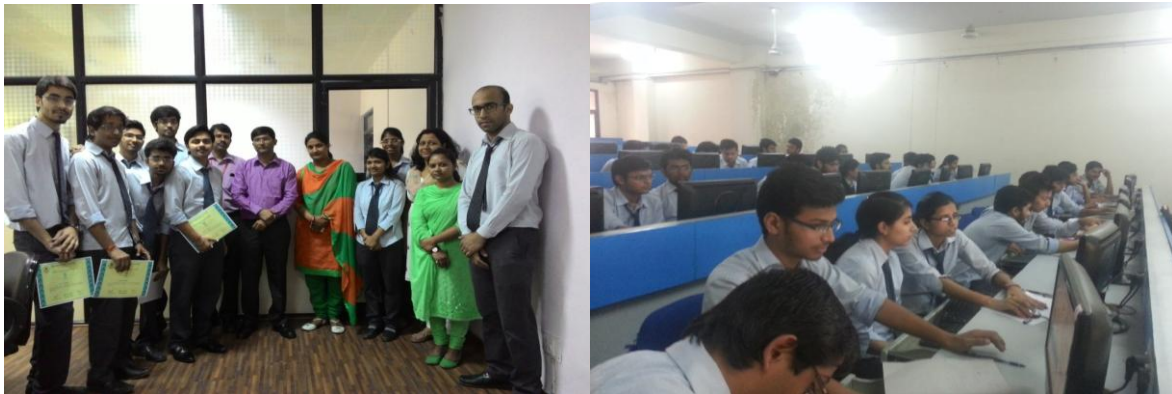
